Research Infrastructures: why do they exist and how to use them to empower your Research

Abstract: Research Infrastructures provide a variety of resources and services to conduct research and foster innovation. Such services, including the use of physical instrumentation, digital or computational resources, are accessible by a wide research community through peer-reviewed scientific proposals, often free-of-charge for the user accessing them, or available at an access cost required to finance the infrastructure operations. Knowing the existence of Research Infrastructures, their working principles, and the opportunities they provide, can make a huge impact on the activities of each researcher. In this seminar, I will provide some scientific and political background on modern Research Infrastructures, their operation and relation to open-science principles, and conclude providing a variety of examples showing the diversity in services and resources one can access.
